
134 Bcf Natural Gas Storage Withdrawal Greater than Expectations of 129 Bcf

The EIA reported a 134 bcf withdrawal for the week ending January 8, 2021. Storage at 3,196 bcf is

157 bcf above last year at this week and 322 bcf above the 5-year average. Expectations were for a 129 Bcf withdrawal. The greater-than-expected withdrawal was bullish to prices, yet prices languished after the data release and ended the trading day down 6 cents. Expectations for a warmer than normal Winter season are pressuring prices down.
