
187 Bcf Natural Gas Storage Withdrawal

Greater than Expectations of 175 Bcf

The EIA reported a 187 bcf withdrawal for the week ending January 15, 2021. Storage at 3,009 bcf is 62 bcf above last year at this week and 310 bcf above the 5-year average. Expectations were for a 175 Bcf withdrawal. Despite the bullish report prices dropped as weather forecasts had shifted from expectations for a severe and prolonged winter freeze in late January and early February to a less intense cold weather that will continue through next month.
